SPECIAL CALLED MEETING 1

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a special called meeting on January 3, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Aldermen Henry, Vassar, Rankin, Brooks, Fender, Sulcer, Davis and Stedman, Mayor Bill Harmon, City Attorney Steve Cobb and City Clerk Virginia Hillman.

Alderman Sulcer led in prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

Ordinance No. 1661 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SHERWOOD NORTH REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 WITHIN THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, PRESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" was read for the first time. A motion was made by Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the second reading. The roll call vote was unanimous. The ordinance was read for the second time. A motion was made by Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Davis to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the third and final reading. The roll call vote was unanimous. The ordinance was read for the third time. Alderman Stedman asked for classification that the purpose of the ordinance be strictly for the creation of a district. A motion was made by Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to adopt the ordinance. The roll call vote was unanimous to adopt the ordinance. The emergency clause passed by a unanimous roll call vote.

Alderman Vassar made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Alderman Sulcer.
