

**January 3, 2008**

**CALLED MEETING 1**

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a called meeting on January 3, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Virginia R. Hillman, City Attorney Steve Cobb, City Clerk Angela Nicholson, Aldermen Vassar, Rankin, Fender, Davis, Sulcer, Brooks and Harmon. Alderman Henry absent.

Alderman Sulcer led in prayer, and the Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

**Ordinance No. 1766 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE REZONING PART OF THE NORTH ½ OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, SHERWOOD, PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS, FROM R-1 (RESIDENTIAL) TO R-1 (CONDITIONAL USE); AMENDING ORDINANCE 729 AS AMENDED; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"** was read.

Alderman Sulcer explained that she would abstain from this issue because she helped the Pulaski County School District with the property. A motion was made by Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the second reading. The roll call vote was 6 ayes, Alderman Sulcer abstained. The ordinance was read for the second time. A motion was made by Alderman Rankin, seconded by Alderman Davis, to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the third and final reading. The roll call vote was 6 ayes, Alderman Sulcer abstained. A motion was made by Alderman Brooks, seconded by Alderman Harmon, to adopt the ordinance. The roll call vote was 6 ayes, Alderman Sulcer abstained. The emergency clause passed with 6 ayes, Alderman Sulcer abstained.

Attorney Steve Cobb announced that January 11, 2008, at 8:30 a.m. Judge Fox would hear the oral arguments on the North Little Rock vs. City of Sherwood and First Electric lawsuit.

Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Brooks, made a motion to adjourn.
