CALLED MEETING 1

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a special called meeting on May 13, 2010, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Virginia R. Ordinance No. 1864, entitled, “AN ORDINANCE REZONING THE PROPERTY AT 7400 HIGHWAY 107 FROM R-1 TO C-3; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AMENDING THE ZONING MAP; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES” was read.
