SPECIAL CALLED MEETING 1

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a special called meeting on July 1, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were City Attorney Steve Cobb, City Clerk Angela Nicholson, Aldermen Vassar, Davis, Sulcer, Brooks, Harmon, Lilly, and McMinn. Mayor Virginia R. Hillman and Alderman Fender absent.

Alderman Harmon, second by Alderman Sulcer, made a motion to elect Alderman Vassar to chair the special called meeting on July 1, 2010. The roll call vote was 7 ayes. Alderman Fender absent.

Ordinance No. 1870, entitled, “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SALE OF ICE CREAM AND SIMILAR PRODUCTS FROM MOBILE UNITS; REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES” was read. Alderman McMinn asked that the ordinance be amended in Section 7. (l) to read *Child customers shall not be allowed inside the vehicle*. Removing the last part of the sentence that states *this provision shall not apply to children related to the driver while riding with the driver along the sales route*. Mike Anderson stated to the council that he was originally against the ice cream ordinance and has no objections to the new revised ordinance. Alderman Harmon, seconded by Alderman McMinn, made a motion to amend the ordinance. The roll call vote was 7 ayes. Alderman Fender absent. The ordinance was read for the first time as amended. Alderman Davis, seconded by Alderman Brooks, made a motion to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the second reading as amended. The roll call vote was 7 ayes. Alderman Fender absent. The ordinance was read for the second time as amended. Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Lilly, made a motion to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the third and final reading as amended. The roll call vote was 7 ayes. Alderman Fender absent. The ordinance was read for the third time as amended. Alderman Harmon, seconded by Alderman Davis, made a motion to adopt the ordinance as amended. The roll call vote was 7 ayes. Alderman Fender absent. The emergency clause passed with a vote of 7 ayes. Alderman Fender absent.
