

**August 12, 2010**

**CALLED MEETING 1**

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a called meeting on August 12, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Virginia R. Hillman, City Attorney Steve Cobb, City Clerk Angela Nicholson, Aldermen Vassar, Davis, Sulcer, Brooks, Harmon and McMinn. Alderman Fender and Alderman Lilly absent.

**Ordinance No. 1873, entitled, “AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$108,313.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO CONSTRUCT CLAREMONT AVENUE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”** was read. City Engineer Ellen Norvell informed the council that there were five bids received with the highest bid at \$179,379.00 and the lowest was \$108,313.00. The projected construction time frame is approximately three (3) months. Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman McMinn, made a motion to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the second reading. The roll call vote was 6 ayes. Alderman Fender and Lilly absent. The ordinance was read for the second time. Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Brooks, made a motion to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the third and final reading. The roll call vote was 6 ayes. Alderman Fender and Lilly absent. The ordinance was read for the third time. Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Brooks, made a motion to adopt the ordinance. The roll call vote was 6 ayes. Alderman Fender and Lilly absent. The emergency clause passed with a roll call vote of 6 ayes. Alderman Fender and Lilly absent.

Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Brooks, made a motion to adjourn at 4:05 p.m.
