CALLED MEETING 1

The City Council of the City of Sherwood, Arkansas, met for a special called meeting on November 9, 2005, at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Bill Harmon, City Attorney Steve Cobb, City Clerk Virginia Hillman, Aldermen Vassar, Rankin, Fender, Davis, Sulcer, Stedman, Henry, and Brooks.

Prayer was led by Alderman Sulcer, and the Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

Ordinance No. 1685 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING A CONDITIONAL USE IN A C-3 COMMERCIAL ZONE LOCATED AT 5426 LANDERS ROAD; AMENDING THE ZONING AND LAND USE MAP; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" was read for the first time. A motion was made by Alderman Stedman, seconded by Alderman Sulcer, to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the second reading. The roll call vote was unanimous. The ordinance was read for the second time. A motion was made by Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Davis to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the third and final reading. Alderman Vassar wants to make sure the business will be advertised in Sherwood. The representatives of the property stated that it would be Sherwood. The roll call vote was unanimous. The ordinance was read for the third time. A motion was made by Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to adopt the ordinance. The roll call vote was unanimous to adopt the ordinance. The emergency clause passed by a unanimous roll call vote.

A motion was made by Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Davis to adjourn.
