

Sherwood Street Committee  
Minutes  
April 13, 2010

The City of Sherwood Street Committee met for their regularly scheduled on March 9, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. in the break room at 2199 E. Kiehl Ave.

Ellen Norvell reported on the following:

- Claremont Drainage – She said we are revising the original plans to include street and drainage improvements because the city doesn't have the plans for the street improvements. Butch Davis asked her about Pinto and Bronco area. She said Tracy Sims has found a FEMA program that may give the city funding for major improvements in the area. She said there are certain conditions that have to be met and we are checking to make sure the conditions can be met.
- Maryland - She said curb and gutter should go in on Maryland by Thursday.
- Brockington – She said the bonds and insurance should be in by the 19<sup>th</sup> and then we can get started on the road construction. She said the punch list for the current half is down to small stuff.
- Lee Street and Abercorn – She said we are working with FEMA because there may be some money to restore them to pre storm condition. She said drainage was not adequate before so they are allowing us to do a hydraulic study to see if we can get additional funds for improvements.

Lanny Leder reported on the following:

- There are 6 Boom trucks running. They are working hard.
- He said the automated trucks are working well.
- Lanny said boom trucks can pick up trees 8ft. by 8" diameter. He said they are not equipped to pick up trees that services cut down.

There was a round room discussion about various drainage issues.

Walt Barnhardt said the crosswalk between the playground and the church at Maryland needs to be inspected for safety issues.

Walt also expressed concerns about the trash in Woodruff Creek. Lanny said that would be an issue for the Corp of Engineers to address.

Kevin Lilly said the patched areas at Brockington and Kiehl need to be filled. Ellen said we may have the contractor do some temporary repairs until construction begins.

There being no further business, Walt Barnhardt made a motion to adjourn. Les Bronson seconded the motion. The ayes carried.
