**REGULAR MEETING 1**

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a regular meeting on September 22, 2003, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Aldermen Henry, Vassar, Rankin, Butler, Fender, Sulcer, Davis and Stedman; Mayor Bill Harmon, City Attorney Steve Cobb, and City Clerk Virginia Hillman.

Alderman Sulcer led in prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

A motion was made by Alderman Vassar to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on August 25, 2003, as transcribed. Alderman Sulcer seconded the motion and the roll call was unanimous.

The Sherwood Police Department presented awards to four police officers for outstanding performance of duty. On August 16, 2003 an overturned vehicle was on fire with the driver of the vehicle trapped inside. Officers Richard Harper, Scott Hicks, Beverly Hughes, and Franck Spence lifted the vehicle and removed the driver out of harms way.

Alderman Sulcer announced that the Advertising and Promotion Commission met and discussed Sherwood Fest scheduled for October 18<sup>th</sup> and the Halloween Carnival scheduled for October 31<sup>st</sup>. Booths are still available. Also, Christmas displays are available for purchase for the Enchanted Forest display. The October meeting will be moved to the 8<sup>th</sup>.

Alderman Vassar announced that the Personnel Commission will meet on Wednesday, October 1<sup>st</sup> at 4:30.

Alderman Fender announced that there will be a public hearing regarding the North Belt Freeway on Thursday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> from 4:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. at Sylvan Hills High School Auditorium.

Alderman Sulcer made a motion, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to suspend the rules and place the following resolution on the agenda. The roll call was unanimous to place the resolution on the agenda.

**Resolution No. 11-2003 “A RESOLUTION NAMING THE SHERWOOD PUBLIC WORKS COMPLEX IN HONOR OF DENVER R. GENTRY”** was read. A motion was made by Alderman Vassar, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to adopt the resolution. The resolution was adopted by a unanimous roll call vote.

Jim Anderson addressed the Council requesting that the City help notify residents of the October 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting at Sylvan Hills High School Auditorium by distributing flyers and posting signs. Greg Chastine addressed the Council requesting that the City take an active role in having the North Belt Loop rerouted entirely away from all residential areas.
