REGULAR MEETING 1

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a regular meeting on November 24, 2003, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Aldermen Henry, Vassar, Rankin, Butler, Fender, Sulcer, Davis and Stedman; Mayor Bill Harmon, City Attorney Steve Cobb, and City Clerk Virginia Hillman.

Alderman Sulcer led in prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

A motion was made by Alderman Vassar to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on October 27, 2003, as transcribed. Alderman Sulcer seconded the motion and the roll call was unanimous.

Alderman Sulcer announced that everyone is invited to a reception on December 1st at 5:00 with the official lighting ceremony at 6:00 p.m. for the Enchanted Forest lighting display. She thanked all of the City staff for their contribution.

Alderman Vassar announced that the December Personnel Commission meeting would be moved to December 11th at 4:00 p.m.

Alderman Fender announced that there was a public hearing on November 20th regarding the Brockington Road widening.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ARKANSAS MECHANICAL CODE, AS AMENDED, FOR THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES was read one time.

Resolution No. 12-03 “A RESOLUTION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARKANSAS CODE 26-75-605, REAPPOINTING JOHN HESTER AND MARINA BROOKS TO THE ADVERTISING AND PROMOTION COMMISSION” was read. A motion was made by Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to adopt the resolution. The resolution was adopted by a unanimous roll call vote.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE PICKUP BY THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, ARKANSAS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was read for the first time. A motion was made by Alderman Rankin, seconded by Alderman Fender, to amend the ordinance to provide exemption for residents age 65 and older. The amended was approved by a unanimous roll call vote. The ordinance was read for the first time as amended. A motion was made by Alderman Rankin, seconded by Alderman Fender, to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the second reading. The roll call vote was 3 ayes and 5 nays.

Resolution No. 13-03 “A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, ARKANSAS, DESIGNATING USE OF CITY PROPERTY FOR A SHERWOOD VETERANS MEMORIAL” was read. A motion was made by

Alderman Sulcer, seconded by Alderman Butler, to adopt the resolution. The resolution was adopted by a unanimous roll call vote.

Resolution No. 14-03 “A RESOLUTION CREATING AN AD HOC COMMITTEE TO SERVE AS LIAISON BETWEEN THE CITY OF SHERWOOD AND THE PULASKI COUNTY SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT” was read. A motion was made by Alderman Davis, seconded by Alderman Rankin, to adopt the resolution. The resolution was adopted by a unanimous roll call vote.

Mayor Harmon announced that the George Brown estate has donated the Round Top Station to the City of Sherwood. The property is qualified to be on the national historical register.

Mayor Harmon introduced Dusty Gilliland and Shawn Rogers along with their scout leader Danny Gilliland.

Mayor Harmon announced that the annual Sherwood Christmas Parade is Sunday, December 7th @ 2:00 p.m. and Breakfast with Santa is Saturday, December 13th from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. at Sherwood Forest.

Attorney Steve Cobb announced the Sherwood Chamber of Commerce annual Christmas Banquet on Thursday, December 5th at North Hills Country Club.

City Attorney Steve Cobb announced that the City was successful in a lawsuit involving changing the master street plan allowing the Fairway bridge.

A motion was made by Alderman Vassar to adjourn.
