**RESOLUTION NO.****A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE RECOVERY EFFORTS NECESSITATED BY THE TORNADO OF MARCH 31st, 2023, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**Whereas;** Central Arkansas suffered extensive damage as a result of an EF3 scale tornado on the afternoon of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. and

**Whereas;** The City of Sherwood experienced significant damage in the storm that will result in recovery efforts in the weeks to come, and

**Whereas;** Proper environmental standards must be observed and followed in the clean-up and recovery efforts, and

**Whereas;** utilization of the same service provider, already in progress in North Little Rock, will provide better assistance to our citizens in the recovery effort.

**Now, therefore, be it Resolved by the City Council of Sherwood, Arkansas;**

**Sec. 1** Given the need for immediate response to conditions caused by the tornado, bidding requirements are hereby waived.

**Sec. 2** The Mayor is authorized to execute all necessary contracts and supporting documents with Tetra Tech, Inc. and CrowderGulf LLC. for the services of disaster debris management and related services.
