

MINUTES
SHERWOOD WASTEWATER TREATMENT COMMITTEE

January 4, 2022

ACTIONS TAKEN

1. Received a report on repairs at the North Plant
2. Discussed a North Little Rock WWU upgrade plan on a collection line with Sherwood.
3. Received a report that Gravel Ridge WWU is not interested in combining operations.

The Sherwood Wastewater Treatment Committee met on January 4, 2022. Chair Amy Sanders called the meeting to order. Present were Chair Amy Sanders and members Kevin Lilly, Eric Fleming, Suzanne Stair and Sarah Breshears. Also present were Wastewater Manager Scott Greenwood, Dennis Webb, and attorney Larry Carpenter.

The November Minutes were reviewed. Kevin Lilly moved, seconded by Eric Fleming to approve the Minutes. This passed 5-0. The December meeting was cancelled so there were no Minutes to review.

Scott Greenwood distributed the Operations Reports for October and November. Scott reported that he expected the Department to meet all inspection goals for the year. There had been no SSO's to report.

There was nothing unusual to report from the financial statements.

Under Long Range Planning Scott reported discussions with Mike Clayton, director of NLRWWU, about a project crossing under the freeway. Sherwood and North Little Rock share the line and are discussing what expenses to share.

Several items of Old Business were discussed. Scott reported a letter from an attorney for Gravel Ridge WWU that it was not interested in combining operations. Scott reported that the Department had consulted about a recent increase in ammonia at the North Plant. The increase was not enough to violate our permit but was unexpected. The consultant provided help with mix of substances in the treatment mix, and this seems to have handled the problem.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned. The next regular meeting will be at noon on February 1, 2022, at the Harmon Center.
