Kevin stated this would be an abbreviated Street Committee meeting because of the workshop immediately following the meeting.

Beverly made a motion to accept the minutes and there was a second by April. The vote was unanimous.


Under New Business, Kevin stated that in late 2021 discussion began for a Project Manager over roadwork being done under the Sales Tax Bond. Richard said he had received proposals from Garver and Crafton Tull. Richard stated, in his opinion, Garver would be easy to recommend because they had done a substantial amount of project work for ARDOT. A discussion followed. Kevin stated there were 20 statements of qualifications received and as a staff you chose Garver and Crafton Tull. Richard stated Garver got the highest number of points and Crafton Tull was next. A discussion followed. Beverly made a motion to support the Engineering Departments recommendation to get a proposal from Garver. Kevin stated the motion died for lack of a 2nd. Kevin stated we need to get something moving and suggested reconvening the Street Committee meeting on another date and inviting Garver and Crafton Tull to the

workshop. Richard stated if we can arrange to meet next week, we could get something on the March agenda for the council. Kevin suggested Monday, 3/14/2022.

Under Old Business, Richard stated the old drainage structure on N. Hills needs to be repaired because of a failure. This would get us the 5 lanes on N. Hills to Hwy. 107. A discussion followed. Kevin stated he would need more details.

April made a motion to adjourn and there was a second by Beverly.
