CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICES CLOSED TO GENERAL PUBLIC

SHERWOOD, Ark. (March 19, 2020) - Arkansas and Federal health officials have advised that social distancing is an important step to take towards preventing the spread of COVID-19. Additionally, the President has issued additional recommendations for public safety over the next fifteen (15) days, which can be found at www.whitehouse.gov. The City of Sherwood is taking extra precautions to protect their employees and personnel.

The City of Sherwood has implemented additional measures aimed at minimizing exposure. Effective Thursday, March 19, all City of Sherwood buildings will be closed to the general public until further notice. Sherwood Police Department will be closed to the general public. As normal, officers will respond to emergency situations and traffic accidents. For non-emergencies, please call 501-835-1425. Regular sanitation and recycling routes will continue. The Green Station drop off located at Sherwood Public Works Facility will be suspended until further notice. The Sherwood Animal Shelter will be closed to the public.
