

ORDINANCE NO. 2296

**AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING THE LICENSING OF PEDDLERS FOR DOOR TO DOOR SOLICITATION IN THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**Whereas**, Ordinance 2212 establishes the rules and guidelines for various types of solicitation and peddling in the City, and

**Whereas**, The onset of the Coronavirus has brought about a serious national emergency in the effort to defend our citizens from infection by implementing social distancing, and

**Whereas**, The City has determined that a temporary suspension of Licenses to peddlers is an appropriate step to minimize social contact.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SHERWOOD ARKANSAS,**

**Sec. 1** Effective immediately, all existing licenses held by any peddler for use in the City of Sherwood are temporarily suspended. No new licenses shall be issued until it is determined that the health emergency has ended.

**Sec. 2** The Council hereby designates the Mayor with the authority and discretion to determine when this temporary suspension should end.

**Sec. 3** It being determined that this action is necessary for the health and well being of our Citizens, an emergency is hereby declared. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage.


